

7th Grade Technology Final Project

Digital Safety Awareness Campaign

Project Goal: Create a professional digital campaign that teaches others how to stay safe online. Your audience may include parents, teachers, and visitors.

Format:

Use Canva or Google Slides.

Your Project Must Include:

- A clear explanation of one online risk (phishing, weak passwords, privacy, digital footprint, etc.).
- An analysis of how hackers take advantage of people (What mistake? What emotion?).
- An ORIGINAL realistic example created by your group (fake message, weak password example, risky post, etc.).
- A detailed prevention section (What to do, why it works, and what happens if ignored).
- An interactive component with at least 3 questions (Real/Fake, Spot the Red Flag, Password Challenge, etc.).

Slide Structure (Minimum 7 Slides):

- Slide 1: Title Slide (Topic + Group Members)
- Slide 2: The Problem (What is the risk?)
- Slide 3: How Hackers Take Advantage
- Slide 4: Your Original Example
- Slide 5: How to Stay Safe (3–5 strong tips with explanations)
- Slide 6: Interactive Challenge (minimum 3 questions)
- Slide 7: Why This Matters (Real-life impact)

Work Timeline (2 Sessions – 2.5 Hours Total):

- Session 1: Choose topic, complete Slides 1–4, and begin prevention section.
- Session 2: Finish all slides, complete interactive section, improve design, and finalize project.
